

**OHIO TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING
July 2, 2007**

CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER – The regular monthly meeting of the Ohio Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman, Herb Hartle, on Monday, July 2, 2007 at the Ohio Township Municipal Building.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Hartle asked the secretary to note the presence of all three supervisors, Herb Hartle, Jim Reid and George Wible.

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – Mr. Paul Weidmann, 114 Highpoint Road had concerns regarding the Stone Quarry and Veterinary Ventures properties. Mr. Weidmann also had concerns regarding the zoning of the Mt. Nebo Pointe hotel site property. Mrs. Carol Weidmann, 114 Highpoint Road had concerns about the Comprehensive Plan. Mrs. Erica O’Dell, 223 Grandview Avenue had concerns regarding the traffic on Grandview since Crawford Road is being closed.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES – Mr. Hartle announced that the minutes were posted on the bulletin board. There being no corrections, Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Wible, to approve the minutes as posted. The motion was carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT – Mr. Sullivan read the treasurer’s report for the month of June. Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Wible, to approve the treasurer’s report as read. The motion was carried unanimously.

INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT Mr. Sullivan read the total invoices due for payment are \$156,808.34 which covers checks #6653 to #6808 (PNC Bank)

POLICE SUMMARY – Sgt. Beck read the police summary for the month of June as follows: The Ohio Township Police Department responded to 201 calls. 27 Alarms, 9 Theft Report, 4 D.U.I., 10 Animal Complaints, 10 Accident, 10 Medical Emergency Calls, 39 Traffic Citations, 92 Miscellaneous Calls. Mr. Hartle read a letter from a citizen commending Officer Hartzell*****

FIRE REPORT - Chief Frazier submitted the emergency and fire report for the month of June as follows: The Ohio Township Fire Department responded to 23 calls. 3 Vehicle Crashes, 2 Vehicle Fires, 6 Structure Fires, 4 Wires Down, and 8 Miscellaneous Calls.

PLANNING COMMISSION – Mr. Hartle announced that the Planning Commission minutes are posted on the bulletin board.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT – Mr. Hartle stated than on Monday, June 25, 2007 Mt. Nebo Road was closed by Allegheny County between Arndt Road and Lowries Run Road. The road is anticipated to be closed through the end of September for reconstruction. Access for all residents and businesses will be made available from Lowries Run Road, onto Mt. Nebo Road. MANAGER’S REPORT – Mr. Sullivan reported that the Municipal Building will be closed on July 4th in observance of the holiday. Mr. Sullivan reported that we received a news release from the Pennsylvania Landscape & Nursery Association regarding the Detection of Emerald Ash Borer.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT – Mr. Reid reported that the road department has been finishing work on the parking lot at the Municipal Building. Mr. Reid reported that the Crawford Road project will begin and that the road will be kept open for Emergency use.

RECREATION REPORT - Park Rentals for the month of July - 3. Park Rentals scheduled for the month of August - 4. The new session for Yoga will begin on July 16, 2007 @ 7:00 PM.. If you bring a friend you will receive a 10% discount. Kiddie Sports new session will begin on July 31 and will be held for 4 weeks. Young Champions POM/CHEER Program has begun. This program is designed for children 4 to 15. They will be participating in the Ohio Township Volunteer Fireman Carnival Parade on Friday, July 20th. WEE Teach U program will begin in July, this program will teach young learners about computers. Summer Camp will begin in mid July, for 2 weeks, for children ages 7 to 12. Community Day will be held on Saturday, August 18, 2007. The committee is looking for volunteers and vendors for the event. The first Movie in the Park will be held on Thursday, July 5, 2007 starting at dusk. This featured movie is Over The Hedge.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS – There was no unfinished business to come before the board this month.

NEW BUSINESS –Mr. Hartle stated we have Resolution 18-07 for consideration. This is a resolution for the Township of Ohio to obtain reimbursement of monies for expenses incurred for the school resource officer to attend training. **Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Wible to approve Resolution 18-07. The motion was carried unanimously.** Mr. Hartle stated we need a motion to approve **Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Wible to grant approval for the proposals. The motion was carried unanimously.** Mr. Hartle stated we need a motion to approve a Lot Line adjustment for the Kipp Subdivision. **Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Wible to approve the Lot Line Adjustment. The motion was carried unanimously.** Mr. Hartle stated we need a motion to approve the Stone Quarry/Huffmyer Plan of Lots Subdivision. **Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Wible to approve the subdivision. The motion was carried unanimously.**

SOLICITOR'S REPORT - There was no Solicitor's Report for the month of May.

CORRESPONDENCE – There was no Correspondence for the month of May.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Wible to adjourn the meeting. The motion was carried unanimously.
