
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 210, CODIFIED AS CHAPTER 89 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO CODE, SETTING FURTHER DEFINITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS AS TO THE USE OF CERTAIN EQUIPMENT AND VEHICLES THAT ARE SUBJECT TO THE NOISE REGULATIONS IN SAID CHAPTER.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio that Chapter 89 of the Code of the Township of Ohio is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 89-4, Definitions, is amended to include the following definition of Off-Road Vehicles: A motorized vehicle with two or four wheels used primarily for recreational off-road travel that does not include properly licensed/registered motor vehicles or unlicensed motor vehicles operated on public roads, or agricultural equipment used in farming, snow removal, or trade for the business of the owner of the property; and
2. Section 89-6, Noise Limitations, is amended to include (L): No person shall operate any licensed or unlicensed off-road vehicle, all-terrain vehicle, dirt bike, go-kart, scooter, or any like vehicle within 200 feet of a residence within the Township, excepting the residence of the owner of said vehicle.
