OHIO TOWNSHIP  
ORDINANCE NO. 282

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 249 AS TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND REGULATION OF A PENSION PLAN FOR THE FULL-TIME NON UNIFORMED EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, County of Allegheny, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same:

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 249 enacted and regulating a pension plan for full-time non uniformed employees was established by the Township of Ohio on February 10, 2003; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 272 amended said Ordinance on June 6, 2005; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio have deemed it necessary to effectuate certain additional amendments to said Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, and it is hereby Ordained by and with the authority of the same as follows:


1. That Section III, Paragraph 3.3, is amended to add the following paragraph: "Effective April 2, 2007, any Plan expenses, as mentioned above, which are authorized to be paid from the Plan shall be withdrawn or deducted from the assets of the Defined Benefit portion of the Plan held under the custody of Nationwide Trust Company, F.S.B., Case No. 632-80333. Also, effective April 2, 2007, no Plan expenses, as mentioned above, shall be withdrawn or deducted from the assets of the Defined Contribution portion of the Plan held under the custody of Nationwide Life Insurance Company, Case No. 632-00140."

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED into law by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio at its regularly convened public meeting held on the 2nd day of April, 2007.
