TOWNSHIP OF OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 274

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 94 OF THE OHIO TOWNSHIP CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN PARKING PROHIBITIONS.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that Chapter 94 of the Ohio Township Code is hereby amended, as follows:


1. Chapter 94-1 is amended to include Paragraph 9(F): Parking is hereby prohibited under the following circumstances: handicap parking spots where properly posted; within 15 feet of a fire hydrant; within 20 feet of any intersection; within 30 feet of any stop or yield stop; on any location where official signs prohibit parking; and/or in front of a public or private driveway.
2. Chapter 94-2(A) is amended to read as follows: Anyone in violation of this Chapter who pays \$25.00 for improper handicap parking; \$10.00 for firelane parking or within 15 feet of a fire hydrant; and \$5.00 for all other violations as set forth herein, in person, Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., or by United States Mail within five (5) days, to the Township of Ohio shall be exempted from any further penalty hereunder.
3. Chapter 94-2(B) is amended to read as follows: Any individual does not pay fines as set forth in Paragraph (A) within a timely fashion, shall be subject to the filing of a formal citation before the Magisterial District Judge. Said citation shall be based upon the designated fines and costs as set forth in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code. In the event that there is not a specific motor vehicle violation under the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, the ticket for parking violation shall be enforced in the same manner provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure. Said violations, specifically addressed in the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code and set forth herein, shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days, plus all court costs, including reasonable attorney's fees, incurred by the Township in the enforcement of this Chapter. Each day or portion thereof that such violation


continues, or is permitted to continue, shall constitute a separate offense. Each Section of this Chapter that is violated shall also constitute a separate offense.
