ORDINANCE NO. 185

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, WHEREBY THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO IS AMENDED BY THE ADDITION OF AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF SMOKING IN CERTAIN PUBLIC PLACES, AT PUBLIC MEETINGS, AND IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE WORK PLACE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio desire to provide a healthy and safe work place for its employees and for the citizens of Ohio Township that utilize municipal facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio has determined that the use of lighted cigars, lighted cigarettes, lighted pipes, or other lighted smoking devices in such closed areas endangers the health, safety and welfare of all individuals within said areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, it is hereby ordained by and with the authority of the same:

1. The following definitions shall apply:

"smoke or smoking" - the carrying by a person of a lighted cigar, lighted cigarette, lighted pipe, or other lighted smoking device.

"work place" - the enclosed indoor area in any and all facilities owned by the Township of Ohio, including all municipal vehicles and the municipal building.

2. No person(s) shall smoke or utilize smoking devices in the work place as defined in this ordinance. A violation of this ordinance is a summary offense punishable by a maximum fine of \$300.00.

3. Any ordinance or part of any ordinance conflicting with the terms and provisions hereof be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

BE IT DULY ORDAINED AND ENACTED into the law by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio at its regularly convened meeting held on the 14th day of JUNE, 1993.
