ORDINANCE NO. 208

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 96 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO TO PROVIDE FOR REASONABLE TIMES FOR PEDDLING AND SOLICITING AND FEES FOR PERMITS ISSUED IN RELATION THERETO.

Chapter 96 of the Code of the Township of Ohio is hereby amended at the following sections, codified as Chapter 96 with the Code of the Township of Ohio, as follows:


1. Section 96-4A(2) is hereby amended to provide daily license fees of \$10.00 per day, \$50.00 per week, or \$500.00 per annum to partially reimburse the Township for the expense of police supervision of transient vendors.

2. Section 96-6 is hereby amended to read as follows: No transient vendor shall deposit any refuse or waste on the streets or alleys or any private or public property in Ohio Township, nor may he parked or stopped for a longer time than is necessary for the reasonable conduct of his business, and under no circumstances shall business be conducted prior to 9:00 A.M. or after 6:00 P.M. on any given day.
