

**OHIO TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REGULAR MEETING  
January 7, 2008**

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**CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER** – The regular monthly meeting of the Ohio Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman, Herb Hartle, on Monday, January 8, 2008 at the Ohio Township Municipal Building.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Hartle asked the secretary to note the presence of all three supervisors, Herb Hartle, Jim Reid and Tom Beatty.

**COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS** – There was no comments from the citizens.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES** – Mr. Hartle announced that the minutes were posted on the bulletin board. Mr. Beatty called for a correction on the Special Meeting Minutes. The time was 3:00 P.M not 3:30 P.M... There being no other corrections, Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Beatty, to approve the minutes as posted. The motion was carried unanimously.

**TREASURER’S REPORT** – Mr. Sullivan read the treasurer’s report for the month of December. Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle, to approve the treasurer’s report as read. The motion was carried unanimously.

**INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT** Mr. Sullivan read the total invoices due for payment are \$107,058.31 which covers checks #7633 to #7795 (PNC Bank), Check # 5791 for \$11,623.38 (National City), Check # 1004 to #1006 for \$21,752.86 (State Fund).

**POLICE SUMMARY** – Chief Micklos read the police summary for the month of December as follows: The Ohio Township Police Department responded to 206 calls. 24 Alarms, 8 Theft Report, 3 D.U.I., 8 Animal Complaints, 36 Accident, 13 Medical Emergency Calls, 7 Traffic Citations, 107 Miscellaneous Calls.

**FIRE REPORT** - Chief Frazier submitted the emergency and fire report for the month of December as follows: The Ohio Township Fire Department responded to 29 calls. 9 Vehicle Crashes, 1 Structure Fires, 8 Fire Alarms, 4 Wires Down, 4 Natural Gas and 3 Miscellaneous Calls.

**PLANNING COMMISSION** – Mr. Hartle announced that there was no Planning Commission meeting for the month of December.

**ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT** – Mr. Hartle thanked George B. Wible for his 18 years for public service to Ohio Township. The supervisors commended him for his strong support, and dedication to this community.

**MANAGER’S REPORT** - There was no manager’s report.

**PUBLIC WORKS REPORT** – Mr. Reid reported that the road department has been doing general maintenance through out the township and working on the addition at the Nature Center.

**RECREATION REPORT** - Park Rentals for the month of January - 3 Park Rentals for the month of February – 1. Middle School Egg Hunt will be held on Friday, March 7<sup>th</sup>, for students 9 to 14. Preschool Story Time will be held on Thursday, January 10, 2008. Spring News Letter will be going out on Friday. April will be recycling month. We will be collecting old cellular phones and ink cartridges. Collection of these items will be at the Nature Center Lower Level. New programs – Photography Class, Belly Dancing,

Microsoft Excel, Buying and Selling on eBay, Basic Digital Cameras, Walking Club and Powder Puff Mechanics.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS** – Park Entrance Bids were received as follows: Investment & Enterprise - \$186,940.00, Vento Landscaping & Construction - \$129,790.00, John Zottola Landscaping, Inc. - \$140,190.80, Ross Jenny - \$33,737.72, Penn Landscaping & Cement Work - \$ 153,517.00, Pampena Landscaping & Construction - \$ 135,075.66. **Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid to table bids until further review. The motion was carried unanimously.**

**NEW BUSINESS** - Mr. Hartle stated we have Resolution 01-08 for consideration. This is a resolution appointing George B. Wible to the Ohio Township Zoning Hearing Board and the Ohio Township Vacancy Board. **Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Beatty, approving Resolution 01-08. The motion was carried unanimously**

**SOLICITOR'S REPORT** – There was no solicitor in attendance.

**CORRESPONDENCE** - There was no correspondence for the month of December.

**ADJOURNMENT** – There being no further business, Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Wible to adjourn the meeting. The motion was carried unanimously.
