

ORDINANCE NO. 190

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 92, WHICH WAS ENACTED MAY 11, 1992, AND CODIFIED AS ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 107, SECTIONS 107.1 THROUGH 107.9 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF OHIO TOWNSHIP, BY SUBSTITUTING A NEW SECTION 107.9.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same:

SECTION I: That Article I, Chapter 107, Sub-section 107.9 of the Code of Ohio Township be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE I, SECTION 107.9 - VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

Any person who violates any provision of this Article shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a summary offense which is punishable by a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00, or in default of payment of such fine, by imprisonment for a period of not more than 30 days. Each day of violation shall be considered a separate and distinct offense.


SECTION II: That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
