

TOWNSHIP OF OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 170

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING PARKING ON ALL TOWNSHIP ROADS FROM NOVEMBER 1ST THROUGH MARCH 31ST OF EACH YEAR, AND FOR MORE THAN FOUR CONSECUTIVE HOURS FROM APRIL 1ST THROUGH OCTOBER 31ST OF EACH SUCCEEDING YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, County of Allegheny, and its is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1 - PARKING PROHIBITED AT CERTAIN TIMES

(a) Parking is hereby prohibited on any Township of Ohio road and/or right of way from November 1 of any year to March 31 of any succeeding year.

(b) Parking is hereby prohibited for more than four consecutive hours from April 1 of any year to October 31 of any year.

(c) Penalties Anyone found guilty by a district justice or other court having jurisdiction, of a violation of this provision of this Ordinance shall be required to pay a fine of \$25.00 or be imprisoned up to five (5) days in the Allegheny County Jail or both.

SECTION 2 All ordinances and/or resolutions of a legislative nature, or parts of any ordinances or resolutions of a legislative nature, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
