ORDINANCE NO. 172

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 170 PROHIBITING PARKING ON ALL TOWNSHIP ROAD FROM 1:00 A.M. THROUGH 8:00 A.M. YEAR-ROUND, FROM ALL TOWNSHIP ROADS DURING SNOW REMOVAL PERIODS, AND FROM ANY AREAS THAT ARE SPECIFICALLY POSTED AND DESIGNATED "NO PARKING".

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, County of Allegheny, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same that Ordinance No. 170, enacted on November 4, 1991, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1 -PARKING PROHIBITED AT CERTAIN TIMES

(a) Parking is hereby prohibited on any Township of Ohio road and/or right of way from 1:00 a.m. through 8:00 a.m., prevailing local time, during the entire year.

(b) Parking is hereby prohibited on any Township of Ohio roadway, defined as the cartway and not including the additional rights of way, during snow removal periods.

(c) Parking is hereby prohibited on Township of Ohio roads and/or rights of way where it is determined by the road supervisor and/or the Chief of Police that parking in said areas would be detrimental to the public welfare and safety, and the Township so designates by the posting of appropriate signs for said zones.

(d) Penalties. Anyone found guilty by a district justice or other court having jurisdiction, of a violation of this provision of this Ordinance shall be required to pay a fine of \$25.00 or be imprisoned up to five (5) days in the Allegheny County jail or both.

SECTION 2 All ordinances and/or resolutions of a legislative nature, or parts of any ordinances or resolutions of a legislative nature, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent to such conflict.
