OHIO TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 126

AN OFFICIAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 103, WHICH WAS ENACTED ON APRIL 10, 1978, WHICH ORDINANCE IS COMMONLY KNOWN AND CITED AS THE PLANNING AND ZONING CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, BY PLACING A SIX (6) MONTH MORATORIUM ON THE APPLICATION FOR, CONSTRUCTION AND/OR ERECTION OF COMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES, TOWERS AND ANTENNAS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Township of Ohio has commenced an exhaustive study of the present Ordinance's provisions relative to communications facilities, towers and antennas, and

WHEREAS, a task force has been appointed to examine the present Ordinance, and to make recommendation to the Board of Commissioners relative thereto, and

WHEREAS, the Solicitor of the Township of Ohio has advised the Supervisors thereof that it may properly place a moratorium on the application for construction and erection of communication facilities, towers and antennas within the Township of Ohio for a reasonable period of time, and

WHEREAS, the Township Solicitor has advised the Board of Supervisors that he believes that six (6) months is a reasonable period of time, and

WHEREAS, during said six (6) month period, the Board of Supervisors intends to adopt an Ordinance Amendment to its Planning and Zoning Code relative to communication facilities, towers and antennas.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AND WITH THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME:

FIRST: That a six (6) month moratorium is hereby placed upon the application for construction and/or erection of any communication facilities, towers and antennas within the Township of Ohio.

SECOND: That the moratorium shall commence on the date of the enactment hereof.


THIRD: That the Building Inspector/Zoning Officer be and is hereby directed to issue no permits for the construction and/or erection of any communication facilities, towers or antennas in the Township of Ohio.


FOURTH: That any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance be, and the same is, repealed to the extent of such conflict.
