OHIO TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 213

AN OFFICIAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF RITTER ROAD AT IRIS ROAD AND BRADSHAW ROAD AT BROADBENT ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Township of Ohio maintains roadways within the Township including Ritter Road, Iris Road, Bradshaw Road at Broadbent Road; and

WHEREAS, a review of the intersections at Ritter Road at Iris Road and Bradshaw Road at Broadbent Road by the Chief of Police and Township Engineer has been completed; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Chief of Police of the Township of Ohio and the Ohio Township Engineer that traffic signal devices be placed at said intersections; and

WHEREAS, the placement of stop signs at said intersection is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of Township residents and other persons who travel on the roadways within said Township.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AND IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY AND WITH THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME THAT STOP SIGNS BE PLACED AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF RITTER ROAD AT IRIS ROAD AND BRADSHAW ROAD AT BROADBENT ROAD.
