ORDINANCE NO. 188

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 103, THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, ADOPTED APRIL 20, 1978, TO DESIGNATE IT CHAPTER 132 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO AND TO MAKE CERTAIN REVISIONS THEREIN.

WHEREAS, the Township of Ohio adopted the Township Code Book in Ordinance No. 181, the Code Adoption Ordinance of Ohio Township; and,

WHEREAS, two penalty sections were inadvertently left out of said Code Adoption Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors have deemed it necessary to amend the Code of the Township of Ohio to provide for said penalty sections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. The penalty provisions in the following sections of the Code of the Township of Ohio are hereby amended pursuant to 53 P.S. § 65741, Clause XLI, to provide for a maximum fine of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), plus costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment thereof, for imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days; §§ 121-6 and 127-2.

Section 2. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any clause, section, phrase or part thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such invalidity shall apply only to the clause, section, phrase or part so declared, and shall not impair the remaining

provisions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. When Effective. This Ordinance shall take effect after passage and publication as required by law.
