

TOWNSHIP OF OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 177

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 91 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO REGARDING OCCUPANCY REGISTRATION RELATING TO INFORMATION REQUIRED AND PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Township of Ohio, Allegheny County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

That Chapter 91, Code of the Township of Ohio, be amended by adding the following underscored language and deleting the following bracketed language:

Section 91-1. Listing of tenants, lessees and occupants of rental property required. Every owner, lessor and rental agent of all residential or commercial rental unit or units must file a list of the names, addresses, and social security numbers [and addresses] of all tenants, lessees and occupants...including a list of the names, addresses, and social security numbers [and addresses] of all new tenants, lessees and occupants.

Section 91-2. Violations and penalties. Each owner, lessor or rental agent of a residential or commercial rental unit or

units who fails to submit such a list or lists as set forth above shall, upon conviction thereof and a summary proceeding, be subject to a fine not exceeding six hundred dollars (\$600.) and/or imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days....
