

OHIO TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING
June 2, 2008

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CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER – The regular monthly meeting of the Ohio Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman, Herb Hartle, on Monday, June 2, 2008 at the Ohio Township Municipal Building.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Hartle asked the secretary to note the presence of all three supervisors, Herb Hartle, Jim Reid and Tom Beatty.

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – There were no comments from the citizens.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES – Mr. Hartle announced that the minutes were posted on the bulletin board. There being no other corrections, Mr. Beatty made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid, to approve the minutes as posted. The motion was carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT – Mr. Sullivan read the treasurer’s report for the month of May. Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Beatty, to approve the treasurer’s report as read. The motion was carried unanimously.

INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT Mr. Sullivan read the total invoices due for payment are \$301,160.10 which covers checks #8454 to #8638 (PNC Bank).

POLICE SUMMARY – Chief Micklos read the police summary for the month of May as follows: The Ohio Township Police Department responded to 217 calls. 20 Alarms, 5 Theft Report, 2 D.U.I., 10 Animal Complaints, 14 Accident, 10 Medical Emergency Calls, 61 Traffic Citations, 95 Miscellaneous Calls.

FIRE REPORT - Chief Frazier submitted the emergency and fire report for the month of May as follows: The Ohio Township Fire Department responded to 20 calls. 8 Vehicle Crashes, 3 Vehicle Fires, 3 Structure Fires, 3 Fire Alarms, and 3 Miscellaneous Calls.

PLANNING COMMISSION – There was no planning commission meeting for the month of May.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT – Mr. Hartle reported that for senior citizens and persons with disabilities, The Allegheny County Port Authority offers a transportation service called Access. It is door-to-door, advance reservation, shared ride transportation provided throughout the Port Authority’s service area. Service is provided from 6:00 A.M. to midnight, seven days a week, and at such other times the places that Port Authority fixed route service is in operation. ACCESS riders pay for their trips with tickets purchased from ACCESS. All ACCESS fares are predetermined. For information on eligibility requirements and how to place a reservation for service, call (412) 562-5353.

MANAGER’S REPORT – Mr. Sullivan reported that the municipal building will be closed on Friday, July 4th in observance of the 4th of July.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT – Mr. Reid reported that the road department has milled 2 roads in the township and paving Ritter will begin weather permitting on Friday.

RECREATION REPORT - Park Rentals for the month of June - 6 Park Rentals for the month of July – 3. Kiddie Sports begins on Tuesday, June 17 and we have 16 registered and a new session had to be added. Young Champions Cheerleading Spring Competition levels 2 and level 3 both got second place. Level 3 made nationals in Missouri to be held this July. Summer Camp begins June 17th.

Walking Club is going well and it meets every Tuesday and Thursday at 10:00 AM at the park. Movies in the Park will be held on Thursday, June 26, 2008 the featured movie is A Cinderella Story. Movie will start at Dusk. Discount Attraction Tickets sold Monday – Friday 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM. “Mommy & Me” Learn to Dance has 3 registered. National Aviary programs will be held on July 31, 2008. The Carnegie Science Center will be at the nature center for Family Science Night on August 7th at 7:00 PM. Web Wise Seniors name has changed to “Silver Scholars, Computer Classes for Boomers and Beyond.” Classes begin May 9, 2008. Belly Dancing and Yoga new sessions begin soon.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS – There was no unfinished business.

NEW BUSINESS - Mr. Hartle stated we have Resolution 12-08 for consideration. This is a resolution declaring the intention of the Borough of Franklin Park, the Township of McCandless and the Townships of Ohio to jointly bid automated refuse and recycling collection. **Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Beatty to approve Resolution 12-08. The motion was carried unanimously.** Mr. Hartle stated we need a motion to approve the repairs to the slide at the Ohio Township Community Park. **Mr. Beatty made a motion to reject the bids for the repairs to the park, seconded by Mr. Reid. The motion was carried unanimously.**

SOLICITORS REPORT - There was no solicitors report for the month of May.

CORRESPONDENCE - There was no correspondence for the month of May.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, Mr. Beatty made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid to adjourn the meeting. The motion was carried unanimously.
