ORDINANCE NO. 260

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, IN THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 77, CODIFIED AS CHAPTER 105 OF THE OHIO TOWNSHIP CODE.

WHEREAS, the Township adopted a Slope Control Ordinance on May 7, 1986, Ordinance No. 77, codified as Chapter 105 of the Ohio Township Code; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that certain changes should be made to the original Slope Control Ordinance, and said Ordinance should be amended in the manner set forth below.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by and with the Authority of the same as follows:


1. Section 105-2.G is added to the Slope Control Ordinance, and is to read as follows: In accordance with Pennsylvania Code, Title 25, Chapter 102, Section 102.4 (b), an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan is required for any earth disturbance activity of 5,000 square feet or more. All Erosion and Sediment control Plans shall be in accordance with the requirements of Pennsylvania Code, Title 25, Chapter 102, Section 102.1-102.51. Prior to the commencement of the earth disturbance activity, the Erosion and Sediment control Plan shall be approved by the Township Building Inspector. At his discretion, the Building Inspector may require that the property owner first obtain the approval of the Erosion and Sediment Control Plan by the Allegheny County Conservation District.
