

ORDINANCE NO. 211

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF OHIO TOWNSHIP, BY ADDING VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMITATIONS TO SECTION 129-2 and 129-3.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same:

SECTION I: That Chapter 129, Section 129-2 of the Code of the Township of Ohio be and the same is hereby amended to change the caption of said paragraph and add the following paragraph:

Operation Of Vehicles Over 10,000 Pounds And Over 20,000 Pounds.

It shall be unlawful to drive, move or operate a motor vehicle, semi-trailer or trailer having a gross weight, including chassis, body, load and driver, in excess of 10,000 pounds over and upon the following roads under the jurisdiction of the Township of Ohio: Gary Drive, Cheryl Drive, Bradshaw Drive, Broadbent Road, and Alcott Drive.

SECTION II: That Section 129-3, be amended to include the following:

...in excess of 20,000 pounds upon any Township highway...or in excess of 10,000 pounds upon the specified roads set forth in Section 129-2.


SECTION III: That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of the ordinance be, and the same

is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
