

Ordinance # 197

WHEREAS, Ohio Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, elected to join the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, effective January 1, 1986, in order to provide a Municipal Pension Plan, which contract is controlled by Ordinance # 187; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Township finds it to be in the best interests of the township to withdraw the plan from the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System because unánimous vote by non-uniform employees

that; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED

- 1) Ohio Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, hereby elects to withdraw the Municipal Pension Plan from the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System effective 12/1, 1995 and directs that all assets and liabilities, including but not limited to the member accounts, municipal accounts and retired members reserve accounts, presently maintained by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System be returned to Ohio Township as soon as practical.
- 2) Ohio Township hereby certifies that an affirmative vote concurring in this action of at least seventy five (75%) percent of all active, vested, and retired members of the plan has been obtained.
- 3) Ohio Township assumes all liabilities for all active, vested, and retired members effective the first day of 12/1, 1995.

All ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with the action are here by repealed as is specifically Ordinance # 187. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
