ORDINANCE NO. 265**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained enacted by and with the authority of the same:


1. That Article IV, Chapter 116, Section 127, of the Code of the Township of Ohio is hereby amended to allow for an increase in the imposition of an Occupational Privilege Tax, hereinafter referred to as the Emergency and Municipal Services Act, in the amount of \$52.00 except any person deriving less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per year and submitting satisfactory proof thereof.
