ORDINANCE NO. 223

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF A PROPOSED TOWNSHIP ROADWAY DESIGNATED CASTONE LANE.

WHEREAS, the plan of lots filed by one Robert Dailey, known as Dailey's Plan of Lots as approved and recorded in 1982 by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, said plan of lots included a proposed 50 foot right-of-way for a road designated as Castone Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Ohio did not accept said roadway but has the statutory right to accept said roadway at the present time; and

WHEREAS, the adjoining property owners have expressed a desire to utilize said right-of-way for the construction of a private roadway, which requires the vacation and/or relinquishment of any and all rights that the Township has to said right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio as follows:

1. That pursuant to 53 P.S.A. §1941 et. seq., the Township of Ohio hereby vacates that 50 right-of-way designated as Castone Lane on the Dailey Plan of Lots, dated June 11, 1982.

2. All Ordinances, or parts thereof in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

3. If any word, clause or part of this Ordinance is legally invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force

and effect.

4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
