

ORDINANCE NO. 191

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 182; WHICH WAS ENACTED MARCH 8, 1993, AND CODIFIED AS ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 101, SECTIONS 101-1 THROUGH 101-6 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF OHIO TOWNSHIP, BY AMENDING SECTION 101-2, PARAGRAPH A.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same:

SECTION I: That Article I, Chapter 101, Sub-section 101-2, Paragraph A, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE I, SECTION 101-2 (A) -
USE OF SEWAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM REQUIRED.

A. Connections. The owner of any improved property located in Ohio Township accessible to and whose principal building is within two hundred fifty (250) feet from the sewage collection system shall connect such improved property to the sewage collection system in such manner, and pursuant to such regulations, as this Township and/or the Authority, and/or the Authority's successors, in interest may require, within sixty (60) days after notice to such owner from this Township to make such connection, for the purpose of discharge of all sanitary sewage and industrial wastes from such improved property, subject to such limitations and restrictions as shall be established herein or otherwise shall be established by this Township or the Authority from time to time.


SECTION II: That any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
