

ORDINANCE NO. 193

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF OHIO TOWNSHIP, BY AMENDING SECTION 66-1 BY ADDING A NEW PARAGRAPH S, AND AMENDING SECTION 132-29 BY SUBSTITUTING A NEW PARAGRAPH E.(3)(b).

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same:

SECTION I: That Chapter 66, Section 66-1 of the Code of Ohio Township be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

PARAGRAPH S

A demolition fee shall be paid in the amount of \$25.00 for buildings up to 1,000 square feet in total area, and \$50.00 for buildings of 1,000 square feet and greater. A separate demolition fee shall be charged for each separate structure.

SECTION II: That Chapter 132-29, Paragraph E.(3)(b) be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

The area of any such sign shall not exceed 32 square feet. Such a sign may be double-faced.

SECTION III: That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
