

**OHIO TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REGULAR MEETING  
February 3, 2014**

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**CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER** – The regular monthly meeting of the Ohio Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman, Tom Beatty, on Monday, February 3, 2014 at the Ohio Township Municipal Building.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Beatty asked the secretary to note the presence of all three supervisors, Herb Hartle, Jim Reid and Tom Beatty.

**COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS** – None.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES** – Mr. Beatty announced that the minutes of the re-organization meeting and the minutes of the regular meeting were posted on the bulletin board. Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle, to approve the re-organization minutes as posted. Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid to approve the regular meeting minutes as posted. The motions were carried unanimously.

**TREASURER’S REPORT** – Mr. Sullivan read the treasurer’s report for the month of January. Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid, to approve the treasurer’s report as read. The motion was carried unanimously.

**INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT** - Mr. Sullivan read the total invoices due for payment are \$185,263.46 which covers checks #18437 to #18584 (PNC Bank), Checks #1177 to #1181 for the total of \$2,010.59 (DEA). Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid approving the invoices due for payment. The motion was carried unanimously.

**POLICE SUMMARY** –The police summary for the month of January is as follows: The Ohio Township Police Department responded to 245 calls. 32 Alarms, 15 Disabled Vehicles, 1 Domestic Disturbance, 5 Theft Reports, 11 Fires (including alarms founded/unfounded), 1 motor vehicle accident, 4 Suspicious Circumstances, 11 Animal Complaints, 17 Traffic Accidents, 19 Medical Emergency/Assistance Calls, 20 Traffic Citations, 3 Lockouts (Vehicle/Bldg), 9 Traffic & Parking Problems, 7 wire/trees/pole down, 8 road department call outs and 82 Miscellaneous Calls.

**FIRE REPORT** - Chief Frazier submitted the emergency and fire report for the month of January as follows: The Ohio Township Fire Department responded to 35 calls. 10 Vehicle Crashes, 10 Fire Alarms, 4 Structure Fires, 3 Water Conditions, 3 Carbon Monoxide Alarm, 2 trees down, 2 wires down, and 1 vehicle fire.

**PLANNING COMMISSION** – The minutes of the January Planning Commission are posted on the bulletin board.

**ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT** – Medical Reserve Corps is a volunteer organization that is comprised of active and retired medical and medically-allied personnel who would respond to major emergencies and public health initiatives. The Allegheny County Health Department is seeking medical doctors, nurses, veterinarians, pharmacists and behavioral health specialists who will be activated to strengthen health response capabilities and support surge problems at hospitals and triage sites.
