MINUTES FROM THE JULY 10, 2025 REGULAR MEETING

The Chairman called the Regular Meeting of the Ohio Township Sanitary Authority to order at the Ohio Township Municipal Park at 5:00 p.m. Present were: Denny Coyle, Herb Hartle, John Sullivan, LuAnn Barna and Mike Basista. Justin Klingenberg, Pat Cannon-Pratt, Engineer Doug Evans and Solicitor Mike Witherel were also in attendance.

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – none.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Ms. Barna made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sullivan approving the June meeting minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT & INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT – Mr. Basista made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sullivan approving the June Treasurer’s Report and regular invoices due for payment in the amount of \$79,500.69. The motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS – None.

ENGINEER’S REPORT – We have scheduled a meeting with Mr. Oliver Zwick, property owner of Lots 348-P-302, 348-P-210, 348-P-278, 348-P-262 and 348-P-250 to be held on July 9th to discuss temporary easements for the geotechnical investigation for the LeGrogan Drive Sewer Replacement project. We have received signed easement agreements from Joseph and Diana Rockey for parcel 348-K-205 and John and Bonnie Schlueter for parcel 348-K-207. Temporary easements yet to be obtained include: Kimberely Zwick at parcel 348-P-285; James and Janet Uhler parcel 348-K-174; and Oliver Zwick at the aforementioned properties. Latest letters dated 6/18/25 notified residents that if a response was not received by July 1st, OTSA may consider proceeding with condemnation. The Uhler’s and Kimberly Zwick have yet to respond.

We have assisted with the calculation of several tapping fees.

We have completed the Consent Order and Agreement Annual Report and submitted to the Health Department.

We will examine the Sewickley Hills sewage pump station for pump replacement.

We have reviewed all of the shop drawings submitted for Watermark Academy and we are waiting for additional submittals.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Ms. Barna, adjourning the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
