MINUTES FROM THE JUNE 1, 2023 REGULAR MEETING

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – none.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Ms. Barna made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle approving the May meeting minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.
