

OHIO TOWNSHIP SANITARY AUTHORITY  
MINUTES FROM THE JUNE 2, 2022 REGULAR MEETING

The Chairman called the Regular Meeting of the Ohio Township Sanitary Authority to order at the Ohio Township Municipal Park at 6:00 p.m. Present were: Denny Coyle, Herb Hartle, John Sullivan, Mike Basista, Justin Klingenberg, Pat Cannon, and Doug Evans. Mike Witherel attended via conference call. Jeff Ciaramella was absent.

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – None.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Mr. Basista made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle approving the May meeting minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT & INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT – Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Basista, approving the May Treasurer’s Report and regular invoices due for payment in the amount of \$175,945.32. The motion carried unanimously.

COMMUNICATIONS – Mr. Hartle shared he received information from PMAA for their 80<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference to be held in Erie on September 11-14, 2022.

NEW BUSINESS – Mr. Hartle made a motion to accept the engineer’s recommendation the Authority’s acceptance of the public sewer on Nicholson Road as an Authority owned sanitary sewer. Mr. Sullivan seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. Sullivan made a motion to approve having the engineer put the Nicholson Road Sewer Extension along the West side (ballfield side) of Nicholson out for bid. Mr. Basista seconded the motion. The motion carried.

ENGINEER’S REPORT –

Nicholson Road Sanitary Sewer

- Several manholes required further work after vacuum testing demonstrated deficiencies.
- Mandrel testing was completed on May 31st.
- Engineer recommends acceptance of extended public sewer as an Authority owned sanitary sewer.

Point of Connection 0-15

- Meeting held at Ross Township with various stakeholders demonstrated that sanitary sewer overflow location, identified in the OTSA Consent Order, is at a location hydraulically above where OTSA (and the Bear Run Interceptor) connect to the Lowries Run Interceptor. Not having an SSO below the OTSA connection point, provides an easier path to Consent Order compliance.

324 Ritter Road

- A deduct meter inspection was made at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Macaleer on May 23, 2022. The deduct installation complies with the OTSA program and its requirements.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT – None.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle, adjourning the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 6:10 P.M. The next monthly meeting will be July 7, 2022.
