

OHIO TOWNSHIP SANITARY AUTHORITY
MINUTES FROM THE JUNE 7, 2018 REGULAR MEETING

The Chairman called the Regular Meeting of the Ohio Township Sanitary Authority to order at the Ohio Township Municipal Building at 7:00 p.m. Present were: Denny Coyle, Jeff Ciaramella, Herb Hartle, and John Sullivan. Rob Trombold and Doug Evans were absent. Clint Reilly represented Nira Engineers.

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – None.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sullivan approving the May meeting minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT & INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT – Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Ciaramella, approving the May Treasurer’s Report and regular invoices due for payment in the amount of \$87,847.39. The motion carried unanimously.

COMMUNICATIONS – Mr. Sullivan reported we received a letter from Allegheny County Health Department stating that our Source Reduction Study now meets the minimum requirements of the COA (Consent Order & Agreement). Mr. Coyle asked about the correspondence from Mr. Wetzel asking for more time to complete the Nicholson Road sanitary sewer easement OTSA is seeking. Mr. Sullivan explained that the time given has not expired yet.

NEW BUSINESS – None.

ENGINEER’S REPORT – Lateral connections: Six (6) at Summer Seat, One (1) at Kiddie Academy, One (1) at O.T. Municipal Park, Two (2) at Thompson Terrace Plan 4 and Two (2) at Overlook Estates.

2018 Sanitary Sewer Cleaning and Televising – Work is primarily complete. Several manholes will be exposed to allow for completion.

ACHD Consent Order Letter and Response – The Authority has received notification of sewage taps from PA DEP.

Mt. Nebo Road Widening – Relocation of sanitary sewer continued during May. We expect sewer relocation to be substantially complete during June.

TOA Easement Encroachment – We are investigating the magnitude of encroachment within the sanitary sewer easement.

UV Transmittance Handheld Device – Engineer recommends purchase estimated at \$3,400 to comply with new NPDES requirements. Mr. Sullivan made a motion to approve the purchase as recommended by the engineer. Mr. Hartle seconded the motion. The purchase was approved.

Mr. Coyle asked Clint if Nira had been monitoring the work along Mt. Nebo, specifically the wall at the bus garage. Clint reported that he will have field inspectors visit the site to monitor.

SOLICITOR’S REPORT – Mr. Witherel was not in attendance, but Mr. Sullivan reported that Mr. Witherel was reviewing the Pine Ridge tap issue. This is a home that has been on the Kilbuck Township line and was recently found to be an Ohio Township property. The new residents have been informed of the need to tap in.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sullivan, adjourning the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
