

OHIO TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING
March 5, 2012

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CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER – The regular monthly meeting of the Ohio Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman, Tom Beatty, on Monday, March 5, 2012 at the Ohio Township Municipal Building.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Beatty asked the secretary to note the presence of all three supervisors, Herb Hartle, Jim Reid and Tom Beatty.

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – None.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES – Mr. Beatty announced that the minutes were posted on the bulletin board. There being no corrections, Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle, to approve the minutes as posted. The motion was carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT – Mr. Sullivan read the treasurer’s report for the month of February. Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid, to approve the treasurer’s report as read. The motion was carried unanimously. Mr. Sullivan reported that the township has yet to receive any monies from Keystone Collections and also Kristen has reported that the County has not sent the real estate tax bills to her.

INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT - Mr. Sullivan read the total invoices due for payment are \$151,683.70 which covers checks #15150 to #15269 (PNC Bank), Checks #1084 to #1086 for the total of \$2,133.41 (DEA), and Check #116 for the total of \$93.00 (Grant).

POLICE SUMMARY –The police summary for the month of February is as follows: The Ohio Township Police Department responded to 205 calls. 25 Alarms, 7 Disabled Vehicles, 7 Animal Complaints, 7 Traffic Accidents, 15 Medical Emergency/Assistance Calls, 52 Traffic Citations, 2 Suspicious Circumstances, 7 Road Department Call Outs, 7 Lockouts (Vehicle/Bldg), 2 911 Hang Up Response Calls, and 74 Miscellaneous Calls.

FIRE REPORT - Chief Frazier submitted the emergency and fire report for the month of February as follows: The Ohio Township Fire Department responded to 14 calls. 3 Vehicle Crashes, 1 Public Service, 4 Fire Alarms, 1 Structure Fire, 3 Natural Gas Odor, 1 Wires Down, and 1 Unknown Fire.

PLANNING COMMISSION – The minutes of the February Planning Commission meeting are posted on the bulletin board.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT –Allegheny County Health Department is offering free smoke alarms for owner-occupied homes, which have no smoke alarms or ones too old to be reliable.

Working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in a house fire by 50%, yet most residential fire deaths occur in homes with no smoke alarms or defective alarms.

The program, funded by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, provides and installs a maximum of two battery-operated smoke alarms in an owner-occupied home.

Mr. Beatty stated we have Ordinance No. 304 for approval. This is an ordinance exempting the Ohio Township Volunteer Fire Company from the rules and regulations governing the use of the Ohio Township Community Park and Park Land. **Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid to approve Ordinance No. 304. The motion was carried unanimously.**

Mr. Beatty acknowledged that both the 2011 audit and the 2011 EIT audit have been completed and there were no findings.

SOLICITORS REPORT – None.

CORRESPONDENCE – None.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Reid to adjourn the meeting. The motion was carried unanimously.
