

**OHIO TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING
March 2, 2026**

CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER – The regular monthly meeting of the Ohio Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Cesar Cenicerros, on Monday, March 2, 2026 at the Ohio Township Municipal Park.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Cesar Cenicerros asked the secretary to note the presence of supervisors Cesar Cenicerros and Brian Krul. It is noted that Township Manager Justin Klingenberg and Township Clerk Amber Zwierzynski were also in attendance.

CORRESPONDENCE – None

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – None

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES – Cesar Cenicerros announced that the minutes were posted on the bulletin board. Brian Krul made a motion, seconded by Cesar Cenicerros, to approve the minutes as posted. The motion was carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT – Mr. Klingenberg read the treasurer’s report for the month of February. Brian Krul made a motion, seconded by Cesar Cenicerros to approve the treasurer’s report as read. The motion was carried unanimously.

INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT – Mr. Klingenberg read the total invoices due for payment are \$347,058.02 which covers checks #38263 to #38320 (PNC Bank), an EFT in the amount of \$2,790.44 (DEA Account) and checks 1185 and 1186 in the amount of \$70,330.30 and an EFT in the amount of \$586.36 (State Fund). Brian Krul made a motion, seconded by Cesar Cenicerros approving the invoices due for payment. The motion was carried unanimously.

POLICE SUMMARY – The police summary for the month of February is as follows: The Ohio Twp Police Department responded to 191 calls. 9 Alarms, 6 Disabled Vehicles, 13 Traffic Accidents, 74 Medical Emergency/ Assistance Calls, 3 parking complaints, 2 trespassing reports, 6 domestic disturbances/PFA/Threats, 23 Traffic Citation, 6 animal complaints, 3 suspicious person/ circumstances, 7 welfare check/mental health, 1 harassment call, 6 road department callouts, 10 fraud/theft, and 21 miscellaneous calls.

Public Works were busy working on the new salt shed. The roof, as well as the front and rear walls, have been erected. The crew continues to make progress by adding lights and securing roof panels. We expect the building to be completed within the next month.

Work continues with tree clearing at the Green Valley property.

Brian Krul made a motion to approve the resolution, and Cesar Cenicerros seconded the motion. All in favor.

Cesar Cenicerros stated that we have the first one-year extension for 2026 with Wright Asphalt for consideration for milling and disposal of bituminous paving materials. Brian Krul made a motion to approve the extension, and Cesar Cenicerros seconded the motion. All in favor.

Cesar Cenicerros stated that we have the Waste Management Contract Extension for an additional two (2) year term expiring in December 2028. Brian Krul made a motion to approve the extension, and Cesar Cenicerros seconded the motion. All in favor.

Cesar Cenicerros stated that we have Chairman, Robert Huffmyer’s resignation letter for acceptance. Brian Krul, made a motion, seconded by Cesar Cenicerros to table the issue. The motion carried.

SOLICITORS REPORT –

In executive session prior to the monthly meeting litigation matters were discussed.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business, Brian Krul made a motion, seconded by Cesar Cenicerros to adjourn the meeting. The motion was carried unanimously.
