

OHIO TOWNSHIP SANITARY AUTHORITY
MINUTES FROM THE MAY 2, 2018 REGULAR MEETING

The Chairman called the Regular Meeting of the Ohio Township Sanitary Authority to order at the Ohio Township Municipal Building at 7:00 p.m. Present were: Denny Coyle, Rob Trombold, Doug Evans and John Sullivan. Herb Hartle and Jeff Ciaramella were absent

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – None.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Trombold approving the March meeting minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT & INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT – Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Trombold, approving the April Treasurer’s Report and regular invoices due for payment in the amount of \$67,546.14. The motion carried unanimously.

COMMUNICATIONS – Mr. Sullivan reported we received a letter from Allegheny County regarding the Annual Wasteland Management Report for the Kilbuck Run Sewage Treatment Plant. This reports states that a projected organic overload is a determination that the projected maximum monthly average organic load entering the plant will exceed the design capacity in the next five years.

NEW BUSINESS – Mr. Sullivan reported we had received a letter from Mr. Chris Wetzel, a property owner along Nicholson Road whose property the sanitary authority is seeking a sanitary easement through. Mr. Wetzel is asking for a sixty (60) day extension so that he may seek counsel on his property. Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Trombold to approve the requested extension.

ENGINEER’S REPORT – Lateral connections: Eight (8) at Summer Seat, One (1) at Duff Road, One (1) at Deer Valley and Five (5) at Overlook Estates.

2018 Sanitary Sewer Cleaning and Televising – Work is approximately 80% complete.

ACHD Consent Order Letter and Response – We are now able to process and summarize flow monitoring data for Health Department.

SOLICITOR’S REPORT – Preparation of Joyce lien payoff; Preparation of draft resolution for condemnation for the properties along Nicholson Road. Mr. Witherel reported that at last month’s meeting Doug Evans was tasked with determining the capacity of the Kilbuck Run Plant due to the inquiry of Sewickley Hills approval of a development tapping in. Mr. Evans confirmed that there would be plenty of capacity to allow for the Sewickley Hills development along with the Sewickley Crossing development in the township.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Trombold, adjourning the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
