

OHIO TOWNSHIP SANITARY AUTHORITY
MINUTES FROM THE MAY 6, 2021 REGULAR MEETING

The Chairman called the Regular Meeting of the Ohio Township Sanitary Authority to order at the Ohio Township Municipal Building at 6:00 p.m. It needs to be noted that due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Board members attended the meeting via conference call. Present were: Denny Coyle, Herb Hartle, John Sullivan, Matt Kalina, Pat Cannon and Doug Evans. Jeff Ciaramella and Rob Trombold were absent.

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – None.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Coyle approving the April meeting minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT & INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT – Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Coyle, approving the April Treasurer’s Report and regular invoices due for payment in the amount of \$348,019.98. The motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS – Mr. Coyle stated we have the bid results for Phase 1 Manhole Adjustment to award. The apparent low bidder was Ben Kramer Construction, Inc. with a bid of \$118,000.00. Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sullivan to award the project to Ben Kramer Construction, Inc. The motion carried.

ENGINEER’S REPORT –

Sewage Lateral Connections

There were five (5) connections at Sewickley Crossing.

Sewickley Crossing PRD Phase 4

Sanitary Sewer construction is nearing an end with only a 350 ft. section remaining.

Manhole 2652 at 122 Cobblestone Drive

Manhole located on slope. Some (maybe 2”) perimeter soil has settled. Manhole is in good condition.

Manhole Raising

Bids were opened for the Phase 1 Manhole Adjustments on Tuesday May 4th. There were two (2) bids received. The apparent low bidder is Ben Kramer Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$118,000.00. Engineer recommends award of contract to Ben Kramer Construction, Inc. for their low bid in the amount of \$118,000.00.

SOLICITOR’S REPORT – None.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle, adjourning the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
