ORDINANCE NO. 113

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM VEHICULAR SPEED LIMITS OF 25 MILES PER HOUR ON GRANDVIEW ROAD AND CRAWFORD ROAD IN THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, AND PROVIDING FOR THE POSTING OF SIGNS AND THE IMPOSITION OF FINES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ACT NO. 81 ENACTED JUNE 17, 1976, KNOWN AS THE "VEHICLE CODE".

WHEREAS, Grandview Road and Crawford Road are public roads located in the Township of Ohio and maintained by the Township; and,

WHEREAS, Act No. 81 known as the "Vehicle Code" authorizes local municipalities to establish maximum speed limits on local roads where speeds in excess thereof are deemed to be contrary to the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants thereof; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio have determined that vehicular speed in excess of 25 miles per hour on Grandview Road and Crawford Road is contrary to the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted as follows:

1. The maximum speed limit for all vehicles subject to the provisions of Act No. 81, known as the "Vehicle Code" traveling on Grandview Road and Crawford Road shall be 25 miles per hour.
2. The aforesaid public roads shall be posted with notice of said maximum speed limits in accordance with the regulations of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
3. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction,

be sentenced to pay a fine of \$35.00. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of Two (\$2.00) Dollars per mile for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the said maximum speed limits set forth herein.
