

TOWNSHIP OF OHIO

Ordinance No. 117

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO UTILIZE AN EXCESSIVE SPEED PREVENTOR, THE VISUAL AVERAGE SPEED COMPUTER AND/OR OTHER ELECTRICAL OR MECHANICAL SPEED TIMING DEVICES AUTHORIZED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, the safety and health of the residents of the Township of Ohio is dangerously impaired by the reason of speeding of motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Township has access to an Excessive Speed Preventor (ESP), Visual Average Speed Computer (VASCAR) and/or other electrical, mechanical speed timing devices authorized by the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania under 75 Pa.C.S. §3368(d); and

WHEREAS, the Township Police Officers are skilled in utilizing the same; and

WHEREAS, in order to prevent and impair excessive speeding, the Board of Supervisors authorizes the use thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of same as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio does hereby elect to utilize an Excessive Speed Preventor (ESP) Device, the make and model of which is Model TK100 Systems Innovation Inc., the Visual Average Speed Computer, the make and model of which is VASCAR Plus and other electrical or mechanical speed timing devices

as authorized by the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania under 75 P.S. §3368(d);

Section 2. The operator of the ESP, VASCAR and/or other electrical or mechanical speed timing devices must be properly instructed and certified to use such equipment;

Section 3. The date, time and place of utilizing the same shall be in the sole and absolute discretion of the Chief of Police or his designated representative;

Section 4. That any ordinance conflicting with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
