

TOWNSHIP OF OHIO
Ordinance No. 120

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING TOWNSHIP OF OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 112 SECTIONS III AND IV, AND SETTING FORTH THE AMOUNT OF BOND AN APPLICANT FOR A SPECIAL HAULING PERMIT MUST POST WITH OHIO TOWNSHIP AND INCREASING THE FEE OF A SPECIAL HAULING PERMIT TO TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS.

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Township of Ohio to adequately protect and maintain the Township roads situate within the Township of Ohio;

WHEREAS, Township of Ohio Ordinance No. 112 was ordained and enacted into law by the Board of Supervisors of the Township on the 18th day of February, 1980 to protect and maintain the Township roads;

WHEREAS, Township of Ohio Ordinance No. 112, Section III, does not set forth the amount of bond an applicant for a special hauling permit must post with the Township of Ohio;

WHEREAS, Township of Ohio Ordinance No. 112, Section IV, sets forth the fee which must accompany the application for a special hauling permit in the amount of TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS which amount does not cover Township expenses in the processing and enforcement of a special hauling permit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Ohio Township that Ohio Township Ordinance No. 112, Sections III and IV, adopted February 18, 1980, are hereby amended as follows:

SECTION I. Section III of Ordinance No. 112 is amended to read as follows:

Section III. Any person firm or corporation or other entity desiring to operate a motor vehicle over and upon any hard surface roads under the jurisdiction of and within the physical boundaries of the Township of Ohio must apply to the Chief of Police of Ohio Township (or his appointee in his absence) for a special hauling permit upon a form prepared by the Township and if any combined job weight is in excess of 100,000 pounds (such as six loads at 20,000 pounds each), the applicant must post a bond with a bonding company authorized to conduct such business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in the amount of ONE (\$1.00) DOLLAR per lineal foot or any fraction thereof to be travelled or driven upon Township roads, guaranteeing the Township that applicant shall and will, upon notice from the Township, repair or pay for any damage to any road damaged by the applicant as a result of the operation of a motor vehicle by applicant.

SECTION II. Section IV of Ordinance 112 is amended to read as follows:

Section IV. Each application must be accompanied by a special hauling permit fee of TWENTY-FIVE (\$25.00) DOLLARS.

SECTION III. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES REPEALED.

That Sections III and IV of Ordinance No. 112 enacted February 18, 1980 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
