

OFFICIAL OHIO TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE NO. 161

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING THE BROADBENT ROAD WATER DISTRICT; AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF WATER LINES IN SAID DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF THE COSTS OF CONSTRUCTION OF SAID WATER LINES UPON PROPERTIES BENEFITED, IMPROVED, OR ACCOMMODATED THEREBY; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of The Township of Ohio, County of Allegheny and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Creation of Water District

Pursuant to a petition filed by citizens and taxpayers owning property in the Broadbent Road area of the Township, and acting upon the authority conferred upon by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio by Section 1609 of the Second Class Township Code, Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, as amended, (53 P.S. Sec. 66609), the Broadbent Road Water District is hereby created by the Township of Ohio for the purpose of entering into contracts, installing water lines and making assessments upon the property owners abutting the said water lines.

SECTION 2. Area of Water District

The geographic area to be constituted the Broadbent Road

Water District shall include those properties located along Broadbent Road and Cheryl Drive, Township of Ohio, as designated on Appendix 1, attached hereto and made a part hereof. A plan of the geographic area to be included within the Broadbent Road Water District shall also be on file at the Ohio Township Municipal Building and may be viewed and inspected during normal office hours.

SECTION 3. Installation of Water Lines

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio is hereby authorized to do all acts necessary to carry out the terms of this Ordinance, including the installation of water lines within the Broadbent Road Water District, the entering into necessary contracts therefor, and the assessment of abutting property owners in accordance with law.

SECTION 4. Assessment of Costs

The costs of the construction of the water line are legally chargeable upon the properties benefited, improved or accommodated thereby, and such properties will be assessed at a rate not to exceed one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of said water line project.

SECTION 5. Severability

If a final decision of a court of competent jurisdiction holds any provision of this Ordinance, or the application of any provision to any circumstances, to be illegal or unconstitutional, the other provisions of this Ordinance, or the application of such provisions to other circumstances, shall remain in full force and effect. The intention of the Township is that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and that this Ordinance would have been adopted if any such illegal or unconstitutional provisions had not been included.
