AN ORDINANCE RE-ENACTING THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCES IN THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA: ORDINANCE NO. , "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING AND COLLECTION OF A TAX FOR GENERAL TOWNSHIP PURPOSES ON ADMISSIONS TO AMUSEMENTS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, REQUIRING ALL PERSONS, PARTIES, ASSOCIATIONS AND CORPORATIONS CONDUCTING PLACES OF AMUSEMENTS TO SECURE PERMITS, IMPOSING DUTIES AND CONFERRING POWER UPON THE TOWNSHIP TREASURER OR OTHER AUTHORIZED AGENT, PRESCRIBING THE METHOD AND MANNER OF COLLECTING THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS ORDINANCE AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF"; ORDINANCE NO. , "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING, FOR GENERAL TAX PURPOSES, A TAX ON ALL AUTOMOBILE TRAILERS SITUATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NON-PAYMENT"; and ORDINANCE NO. , "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING, FOR GENERAL TAX PURPOSES, A PER CAPITA TAX ON ALL ADULT RESIDENTS OF OHIO TOWNSHIP, STATING WHO SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE TAX, THE AMOUNT OF THE TAX, WHEN IT SHALL BE PAID AND THE PENALTIES THEREFOR."

BE IT ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Ohio Township, pursuant to the Act of General Assembly of Pennsylvania, approved June 25, 1947, P.L. 1145, as amended May 9, 1949, P.L. 898 and, thereafter, that the following tax ordinances now existent in Ohio Township are hereby re-enacted:

1. Ordinance No. 19 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING AND COLLECTION OF A TAX FOR GENERAL TOWNSHIP PURPOSES ON ADMISSIONS TO AMUSEMENTS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, REQUIRING ALL PERSONS, PARTIES, ASSOCIATIONS AND CORPORATIONS CONDUCTING PLACES OF AMUSEMENTS TO SECURE PERMITS, IMPOSING DUTIES AND CONFERRING POWER UPON THE TOWNSHIP TREASURER OR OTHER AUTHORIZED AGENT, PRESCRIBING THE METHOD AND MANNER OF COLLECTING THE TAX IMPOSED BY THIS ORDINANCE AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF."
2. Ordinance No. 17 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING, FOR GENERAL TAX PURPOSES, A TAX ON ALL AUTOMOBILE TRAILERS SITUATED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NON-PAYMENT."
3. Ordinance No. 18 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING, FOR GENERAL TAX PURPOSES, A PER CAPITA TAX ON ALL ADULT RESIDENTS OF OHIO TOWNSHIP, STATING WHO SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE TAX, THE AMOUNT OF THE TAX, WHEN IT SHALL BE PAID AND THE PENALTIES THEREFOR."
