ORDINANCE NO. 307

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, IN THE COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE POLICE PENSION PLAN FROM THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the police pension plan has been enrolled with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System for a period of at least five years; and

WHEREAS, by copy of this Ordinance, the Township is certifying to the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System Board that an affirmative vote approving a withdrawal from the system has been obtained from at least 75 percent of the municipal employees; and

WHEREAS, by this Ordinance, the Township of Ohio acknowledges its responsibility to assume and provide for all future benefit payments to the existing active, inactive, vested and retired members and their beneficiaries effective upon the withdrawal; and

WHEREAS, that the specified date for plan withdrawal shall establish a first day of a month not earlier than the month after which the Township Board of Supervisors are scheduled to take action on the withdrawal application, as there are retired members on active pay status, and it will be set based upon the Supervisor's advisement as to the date it will schedule action on said withdrawal application.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio as follows:

1. That the police pension monies are hereby authorized to be withdrawn from the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, pursuant to the Rules and Regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System Board.
