ORDINANCE NO. 312

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, NAMING THE PLAN ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE OHIO TOWNSHIP POLICE PENSION PLAN, AND RE-AFFIRMING THE RELEVANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE OHIO TOWNSHIP POLICE PENSION PLAN AGREEMENT DATED DECEMBER 1, 1995.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Township Pension Plan is currently enrolled in the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the Township has taken the necessary steps, as memorialized in Ordinance No. 307, to withdraw said police pension from the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 307 establishes Ohio Township's responsibility to assume and provide for all future benefit payments to the existing active, inactive, vested and retired members and their beneficiaries effective upon the withdrawal; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Pension Plan Agreement as so stated, and name a pension plan administrator.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio as follows:

1. That upon withdrawal of the Ohio Township Police Plan from the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, effective August 1, 2014, the Township hereby names Heffron Tillotson as their new Pension Plan Administrator, replacing the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System Board. Further, this appointment of Heffron Tillotson is subject to any future resolution or ordinance of the Township as to naming a new administrator pursuant to applicable law.
2. That the Ohio Township Police Plan Agreement, setting forth the terms and conditions of said pension benefits, is hereby reaffirmed and amended to remove reference to enrollment in the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, and acknowledge the appointment of a new administrator. All other terms and conditions as set forth in the Agreement of September 1, 1995, are hereby affirmed. This Agreement is subject to any future resolution or ordinance of the Township, and can be so amended at any time.
