ORDINANCE NO. 322

AN ORDINANCE OF OHIO TOWNSHIP RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE POLICE EMPLOYEES PENSION, ANNUITY, INSURANCE AND BENEFIT FUND OR FUNDS, TO AMEND CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE PENSION PLAN OR PROGRAM APPLICABLE TO THE POLICE OF SAID TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors ("Board") of Ohio Township ("Township") and it is HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by authority of the same:


The Ohio Township Police Pension Plan ("Plan"), which was established under the provisions of Pub. Law 1804, 53 Pa. Con. Stat. Ann. 767, et seq., (sometimes referred to as Act 600) for the benefit of the Township's police employees and which has been amended and restated by resolutions of the Board thereafter, shall be, and hereby is, amended and supplemented in the following respects:

The Plan is hereby amended to remove current Section 3.02 and substitute in its place the following:

- 3.02 Reduction of Participant Contributions – The governing body of the Township, may, on an annual basis, by ordinance, reduce or eliminate payments in the fund by members. Beginning January 1, 2017 employee contributions shall be ¼ of 1% of Participant Compensation.
