ORDINANCE NUMBER 327

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 249 AS TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND REGULATION OF A PENSION PLAN FOR THE FULL-TIME NON-UNIFORMED EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO.

Be It Ordained and Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the Authority of the same:

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 249 establishing and regulating a pension plan for full-time Non-Uniformed Employees was established by the Township of Ohio on February 10, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township have deemed it necessary to effectuate certain amendments to said ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Township of Ohio, Allegheny County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows:


Death Benefit:

Upon the death of a participant who is fully vested with a deferred vested retirement benefit payable, a benefit in the amount of one-half (1/2) of the member's accrued benefit as of the date of the member's death shall be provided to the surviving spouse. Death benefit under this Section shall be payable and commence on the first day of the month following vested members death. Benefits shall cease with last payment the same month as spouse death. This Ordinance is an amendment to the Non-Uniformed Employees Pension Plan as set forth in Ordinance No. 249.
