ORDINANCE NO. 36

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 7
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO ENTITLED "AN
ORDINANCE OF OHIO TOWNSHIP DEFINING
DISORDERLY CONDUCT AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF",
BY INCREASING THE PENALTIES.

IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of
Supervisors of Ohio Township.

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 7 entitled "An
Ordinance of Ohio Township Defining Disorderly Conduct and Pro-
viding Penalties for Violations Thereof" is hereby amended.

Section 2. Section 2 shall be amended by changing
the amount of the fine and shall provide as follows:

Any person or persons violating this
Ordinance, or causing or helping others
to violate the same, shall upon summary
conviction thereof, before a Justice of
the Peace, be sentenced to pay the costs
of prosecution and a fine not exceeding
Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each such
offense, and in default of the payment
thereof, shall be sentenced and committed
to the County Jail or Workhouse for a
period not exceeding ten (10) days.

Section 3. All other sections of the said Ordinance shall remain as heretofore.

September, 1958.
