TOWNSHIP OF OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING A DEPOSIT OR DUMPING OF GARBAGE,
RUBBISH OR OTHER REFUSE MATERIALS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF OHIO

Pursuant to Act of July 10, 1947, P. L. 1481, Section 702, VIII
and XXIX, the Board of Supervisors of Ohio Township ordained and enacted as
follows:

I. It is unlawful to dump, throw or otherwise deposit ashes,
garbage, rubbish or other refuse materials anywhere within the
geographic limits of Ohio Township.

II. Any person, firm, partnership or corporation violating the
provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be
liable to a fine not exceeding \$100 together with costs for each
offense and upon failure to pay such fine by imprisonment in the
Allegheny County Jail for a period not exceeding 30 days. All
fines and penalties imposed by this Ordinance shall be recover-
able by summary proceedings before any Justice of the Peace in
said township.

III. All ordinances heretofore existing and inconsistent with
this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with
this Ordinance.

Ordained and enacted into law by the Board of Supervisors of Ohio
Township on the 16th day of December, 1959.
