

TOWNSHIP OF OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 7 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF OHIO TOWNSHIP DEFINING DISORDERLY CONDUCT AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF" AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 36 BY FURTHER INCREASING THE PENALTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Ohio Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same.

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 7 entitled "An Ordinance of Ohio Township defining disorderly conduct and providing penalties for violation thereof", as amended by Ordinance No. 36, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Any person or persons violating this Ordinance or causing or helping others to violate the same shall, upon summary conviction thereof before a Justice of the Peace, be sentenced to pay the cost of prosecution and a fine not exceeding Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars for each such offense and in default of the payment thereof, shall be sentenced and committed to the Allegheny County Jail or Workhouse for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days."

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into a law this 15th day of June, 1960.
