ORDINANCE NO. 53

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 35 PROHIBITING TRANSIENT VENDORS FROM SOLICITING SALES OR ORDERS IN OHIO TOWNSHIP

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Ohio Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 35 enacted September 17, 1958, entitled "An Ordinance prohibiting the canvassing or soliciting of goods, wares and merchandise within the Township of Ohio by hockers, peddlers, solicitors, itinerant merchants or transient vendors, not having been requested or invited to do so by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of private residences, providing exceptions and prescribing penalties for violation", having been superseded by Ordinance No. 50 enacted August 23, 1961, is hereby repealed.
