

OHIO TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO 6

An Ordinance of Ohio Township amending Zoning Ordinance number Four (4), providing for the re-zoning of that portion of the Township hereinafter described from a residential (R-1) District to a Commercial (C-2) District.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of the Township of Ohio and it is hereby ordained and enacted by and with the authority of the same.

SECTION 1: That from and after the adoption of this Ordinance the following described premises shall be re-zoned from Residential (R-1) District to a Commercial (C-2) District, and that the Zone Map shall be made to conform therewith. The Limits of the C-2 District shall be amended to include the following area: All that portion of ground of Reed and of Capizzi extending from the existing zone line between zones (C-2) and (R-1) to a line parallel to the existing zone line extending from the westerly line now of Reed through the northerly line of Capizzi to the line now of Cotton and Capizzi.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
