

TOWNSHIP OF OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPEED
LIMIT OF 35 MILES PER HOUR ON CER-
TAIN DESIGNATED ROADS IN OHIO
TOWNSHIP OWNED BY THE COUNTY OF
ALLEGHENY, AND PROVIDING FOR THE
ENFORCEMENT THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that many motor vehicles travelling certain county-owned roads located in Ohio Township are doing so at speeds in excess of those deemed proper for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of said Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Ohio Township, and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same in accordance with the provisions of the Act of April 29, 1959, P. L. 58, and pursuant to the authority and consent granted to said Supervisors by the County of Allegheny, there is hereby established on the following designated roads located in the Township, a speed limit of thirty-five (35 m.p.h.) miles per hour:

1. Lowries Run - Mt. Nebo Road where it intersects between Legislative Route 02100 and Camp Horne Road, a distance of 1.6 miles.
2. Horne Camp Road from Ohio Township line to Ben Avon - Lowries Run Road located in Ohio Township, a distance of eight tenths (.8) mile.


2. The Board of Supervisors hereby authorize and direct placement of thirty-five (35 m.p.h.) miles per hour speed limit signs on the above designated roads in accordance with the provisions of the Act of April 29, 1959, P. L. 58.


3. The penalties for violation of the afore-said established speed limit shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Act of April 29, 1959, P. L. 58.
