ORDINANCE NO. 95

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 66 ENACTED APRIL 15, 1967, PROVIDING FOR RULES, RATES AND REGULATIONS FOR SEWAGE SERVICE, CONNECTION AND USE BY OWNERS OF OHIO TOWNSHIP, BY INCREASING THE SEWAGE SERVICE CHARGES PROVIDED IN SECTION IX THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the cost of use, maintenance and repair of the sewer lines owned by the Township of Ohio has increased substantially since the enactment of the prior Ordinance establishing the present sewage service charges.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and is hereby ordained and enacted by and with authority of the same that Paragraphs 42, 43 and 44 of Section IX entitled, "SEWAGE SERVICE CHARGES AND TERMS OF PAYMENT" as set forth on pages 31 and 32 of the printed booklet, together with the diagram of Standard Detail for Sanitary Sewer and House Lateral prepared by L. Robert Kimball, Consulting Engineer, are hereby amended to read as follows:

42. Initial Service Charge.

An initial service charge of \$400.00 per user shall be paid in advance at the time application for sewer service is made. This charge shall pay for the inspection of the service line and the tape-in to the sewer collector line. For developers who install their connections the same initial service charge shall apply.

43. Domestic Users.

The sewage service charge for domestic users shall be \$9.00 per month, payable quarterly. If the amount due for any quarter is not paid by the 10th day of the second month following the quarter for which payment is being made, there shall be added to the bill a penalty charge of 10% of the gross amount due. The Township reserves the right to discontinue sewage service on or after the 10th day of the second month following the quarter for which sewage service was furnished if such gross charge, including the 10% penalty, has not been paid.

44. Other Domestic Users.

All properties which are connected into the Ohio Township sewage system and which are not domestic users, as previously defined, shall pay for the sewage service a monthly rate under the same terms and conditions as for domestic users, which rate shall be determined by multiplying the domestic rate of \$9.00 per month by the number of domestic units of water consumed in any calendar quarter. The number of domestic units of water consumed shall be determined by dividing the total metered water consumption of said user for any calendar quarter by 12,000. For example: If a property other than a domestic unit consumed by water meter 144,000 gallons of water in any quarterly period, the gross sewage service charge will be 144,000 divided by 12,000, or 12 time \$9.00 times three, or \$324.00. If the amount due for any quarter is not paid by the 10th day of the second month following the quarter for

which payment is being made, there shall be added to the bill a penalty charge of 10% to the gross amount due.

In the case of industrial plants, or other users than domestic customers for which it is necessary for the Township to install facilities to be used only by such users, a monthly charge for sewage service shall be computed which shall compensate the Township for the cost of construction of such special facilities, and shall provide revenue to the Township to cover the full cost of providing such sewage service.
