

TOWNSHIP OF OHIO

Ordinance No. 96

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 94 WHICH CREATED THE OFFICE OF THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER AND PROVIDED FOR THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF SAID OFFICE AND SET THE AMOUNT OF BOND FOR THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES OF SAID OFFICE.

Whereas, on September 9, 1974 the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Ohio enacted Ordinance No. 94 creating the office of Township Manager providing for the duties and responsibilities of said office and setting forth the amount of bond for the faithful performance of the duties of said office; and,

Whereas, one of the duties and responsibilities set forth in paragraph 2D provides that the Township Manager shall "Collect all taxes not required by law to be collected by the Township Tax Collector."; and,

Whereas, the earned income tax is one of the municipal taxes presently collected by the Township Manager; and, Whereas, the Supervisors have determined that the collection of the said earned income tax by the Tax Collector for the Avonworth School District would be less expensive and more efficient than present methods, and therefore in the best interest of the residents of the Township.

Now, therefore, Supervisors of the Township of Ohio do hereby enact as follows:

1. Paragraph 2D of Ordinance No. 94 enacted the 9th day of September, 1974 is hereby amended to read as follows:

D. Collect all taxes, exclusive of earned income taxes, not required by law to be collected by the Township Tax Collector.

Enacted into law this 7 day of December, 1974.
