

OHIO TOWNSHIP SANITARY AUTHORITY
MINUTES FROM THE SEPTEMBER 1, 2016 REGULAR MEETING

The Chairman called the Regular Meeting of the Ohio Township Sanitary Authority to order at the Ohio Township Municipal Building at 7:00 p.m. Present were: Denny Coyle, Jeff Ciaramella, Herb Hartle, John Sullivan, and Clint Reilly. Rob Trombold was absent.

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – Lucy Guttendorf, Sewickley Hills Borough Council member and Joe Warick, 22 Sewickley Hills Drive inquired to the status of the takeover of the lines in Sewickley Hills. The Authority solicitor stated that the proposal for televising the lines before any final determination is made is still being considered. The solicitor for Sewickley Hills and the Authority Solicitor continue to discuss.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Mr. Sullivan made a motion, seconded by Mr. Ciaramella approving the meeting minutes as posted. The motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT & INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT – Mr. Ciaramella made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sullivan, approving the August Treasurer’s Report and regular invoices due for payment in the amount of \$86,620.90. The motion carried unanimously.

ENGINEER’S REPORT – Lateral connections: Two at Deer Valley Estates, One at Cobblestone, One at Overlook Estates, Four at TOA Sewickley Ridge, One at Blackburn, and One at Diamond Run.

Nature Center Sewerage Extension – the executed agreement by the Catholic Diocese has been sent to the solicitor for recording. Contracts have been executed by R & B Contracting and Excavating, Inc and Notice to Proceed with the project was issued August 24, 2016.

SOLICITOR’S REPORT – Sewickley Hills sanitary line takeover issues discussed with Attorney Art Leonard.

ADJOURNMENT – There being no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Hartle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Sullivan, adjourning the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
