

OHIO TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING
September 6, 2017

CALLING THE MEETING TO ORDER – The regular monthly meeting of the Ohio Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman, Tom Beatty, on Wednesday, September 6, 2017 at the Ohio Township Municipal Building.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Beatty asked the secretary to note the presence of supervisors, Jim Reid, Herb Hartle and Tom Beatty.

COMMENTS FROM THE CITIZENS – Gerry Marshall, 109 Presidents Drive of the TOA Sewickley Ridge Government Affairs Committee was in attendance.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES – Mr. Beatty announced that the minutes from the regular monthly meeting were posted on the bulletin board. Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle, to approve the minutes as posted. The motion was carried unanimously.

TREASURER’S REPORT – Mr. Sullivan read the treasurer’s report for the month of August. Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle, to approve the treasurer’s report as read. The motion was carried unanimously.

INVOICES DUE FOR PAYMENT - Mr. Sullivan read the total invoices due for payment are \$188,604.10 which covers checks #24948 to #25089 (PNC Bank) and Checks #1301 & 1302 in the amount of \$1,275.00 (DEA Fund). Mr. Reid made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hartle approving the invoices due for payment. The motion was carried unanimously.

POLICE SUMMARY –The police summary for the month of August is as follows: The Ohio Township Police Department responded to 272 calls. 21 Alarms, 4 Disabled Vehicles, 12 Thefts/Theft Reports, 13 Fires (including alarms founded/unfounded), 2 motor vehicle accidents, 10 Traffic Accidents, 27 Medical Emergency/Assistance Calls, 72 Traffic Citations, 2 Traffic & Parking Problems, 3 vehicle/building lockouts, 4 trees down, 6 suspicious person/ circumstances/autos, 2 hazardous conditions, 7 open doors/windows, 9 animal complaints, 6 assisting other agencies, 6 foot patrols, and 66 miscellaneous calls.

FIRE REPORT - Chief Penfield was out of town and unable to provide the report for August.

MS4 Report – Joe Jackson reports that he continues to work with both developers and home owners on storm water controls for development and responding to stormwater related complaints and runoff issues. He placed public education flyers in various public places within the township. Joe attended a MS4 funding strategies class at Findlay Township.

BOUNDARY STUDY UPDATE – Mr. Sullivan reported there will be a meeting on October 11th at the Kilbuck municipal building.

PLANNING COMMISSION – The minutes of the August Planning Commission meeting are incomplete at this time.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT – The Ohio Township Volunteer Fire Company held it’s 17th Annual Golf Outing yesterday. Even with a slightly rainy start to the morning, 96 golfers participated in the event which was held at Diamond Run. Dinner followed at the Mayernik Center in Avonworth Community Park.
